<p>We have made an attempt to leapfrog a rather dark period in the lifespan of Rioja. Once a wine on the lips and in the cellars of collectors around the world, the region fell prey, like so many others, to the gravitational pull of a few critics who championed heavily manipulated and manufactured wines. What was unique and special about the wines of Rioja disappeared in favor of a homogeneous formula. It's taken some time but things are bouncing back. Younger, more enlightened producers are asking questions, farming organically and pushing the envelope. And if you want to see how the greats of yesterday are holding up we have a handful of special aged bottles to enjoy.</p>

The west side of Sicily is hardly a bastion for fine wine. Its' most renowned product, Marsala, was long ago exiled from the cellar to the pantry. Recently, however, we have seen a smattering of very interesting things emerge from a nook just west of Palermo near the Golfo di Castellammare. At the head of this class, without question, is Alessandro Viola. Growing up in a winemaking family, Viola went to enology school before visiting some of the worlds' most compelling wine regions honing his craft and finding his voice. When he returned home, he was armed with sufficient skill to craft wine in the most natural of ways without sacrificing clarity, precision, a sense of place and the intrinsic character of his produce. He is a standard bearer not only for western Sicily but for natural Italian wines in general. Here we offer a small sampling of his lineup. We think they are all incredible wines and incredible values.
